






Fast-track options

Deakin College diploma courses offer a fast-track option, allowing you to complete a program in just eight months. This makes it possible to enter university much earlier than students studying in a conventional pathway program.



Small class and tutorial groups

Small class sizes are one of the benefits of studying at Deakin College. With a maximum of 30 students per class, complemented by small group tutorials and workshops, you will receive intensive academic contact and support.



* Entry to Deakin University is based on successful completion of a Deakin College diploma with a WAM of 50 (except Laws and Biomedical Science which require a WAM of 70). Some degrees, such as the undergraduate engineering courses or Bachelor of Laws will take longer than 3 years to complete.
