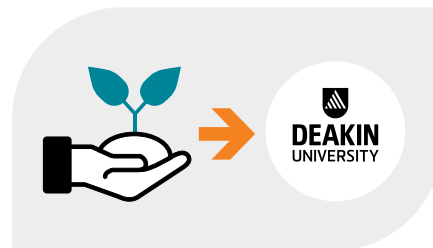

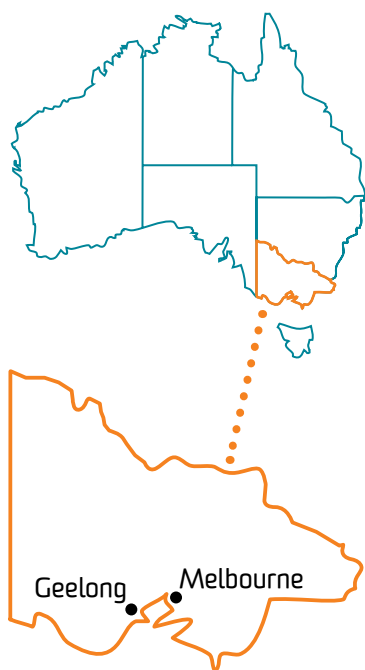

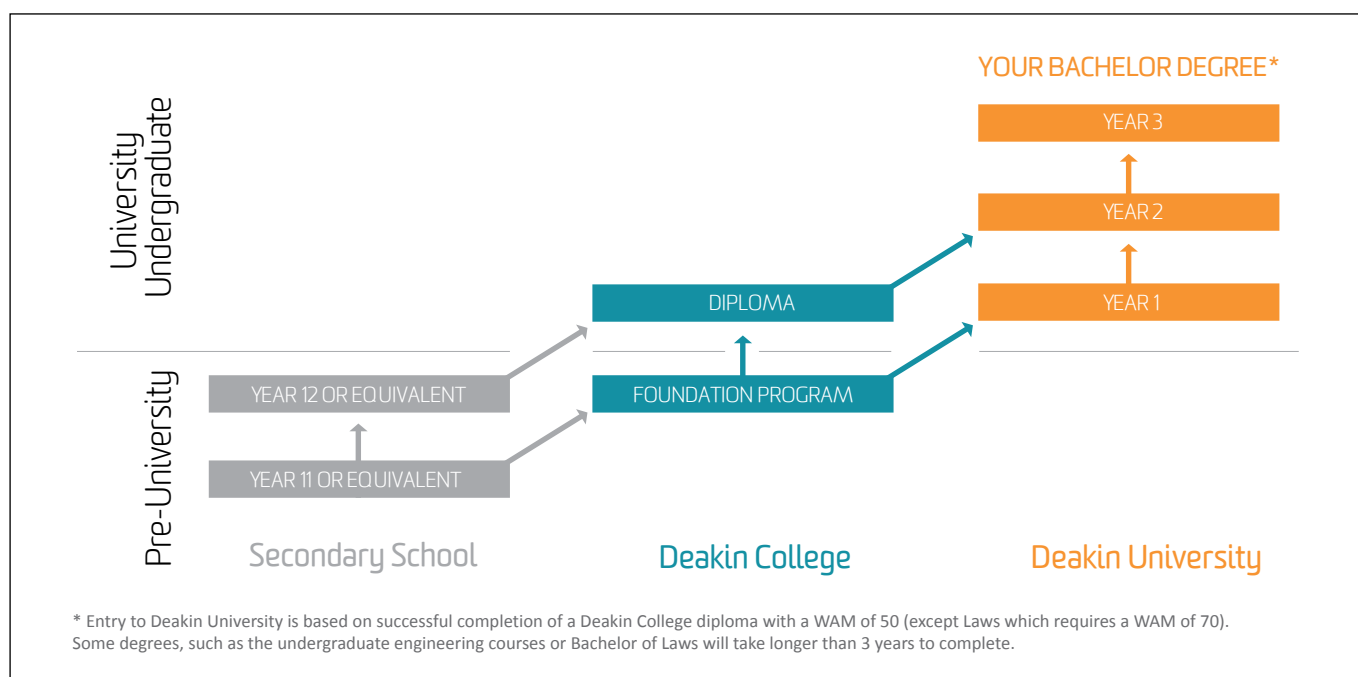
Fast-track options
