

Deakin College Early Acceptance Bursary



A bursary for students starting in Trimester 2 or 3, 2025

We are excited to offer a limited number of **\$1,000 Early Acceptance Bursaries** to new international students commencing at Deakin College in Trimester 2 and Trimester 3, 2025.

This bursary can be awarded in conjunction with the Deakin College International Scholarship, but be quick, only a limited number of bursaries are available.

To be awarded a Deakin College Early Acceptance Bursary, you must meet all of the following criteria:

- be a citizen of Brunei, Cambodia, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Laos, Macau, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Timor-Leste or Vietnam, residing outside of Australia; or be a citizen of any country, residing onshore in Australia
- enrol as an international student
- commence a Foundation or Diploma program in Trimester 2 or Trimester 3, 2025
- accept your offer after 14 March 2025 and before the cut-off date of 23 May 2025 (Trimester 2) or 5 September 2025 (Trimester 3), or before bursary allocation has been exhausted, whichever comes sooner.

Bursary conditions

- This bursary is not transferable or refundable
- This bursary will not be awarded if you do not accept your offer or enrol into your course by the dates specified in your Letter of Offer
- If you apply for a deferral, you will not be eligible for the bursary upon your return
- If you withdraw, defer or are terminated from your course, you will not be eligible for the bursary.

To accept your offer and be automatically considered for this bursary, please refer to the instructions in your Letter of Offer and follow the steps. You can then look forward to receiving your bursary in your student account after the census date (Trimester 2 census: 18 July 2025 and Trimester 3 census: 14 November 2025).
