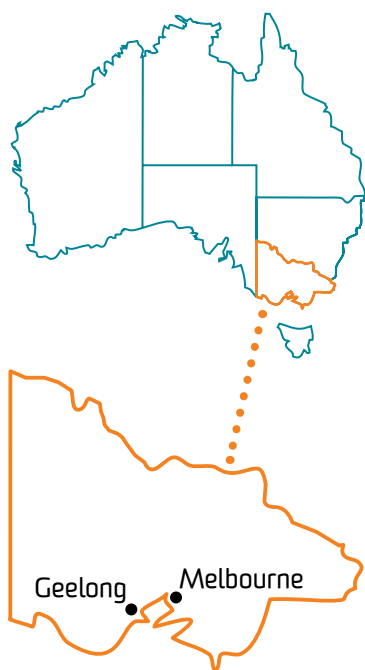

# Your pathway to Deakin University

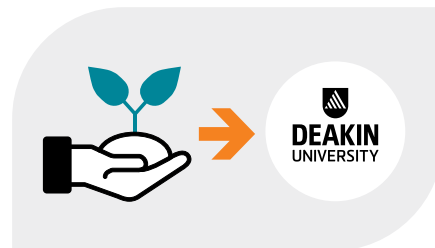
Deakin College programs can provide an entry point into the first or second year of your bachelor's degree.

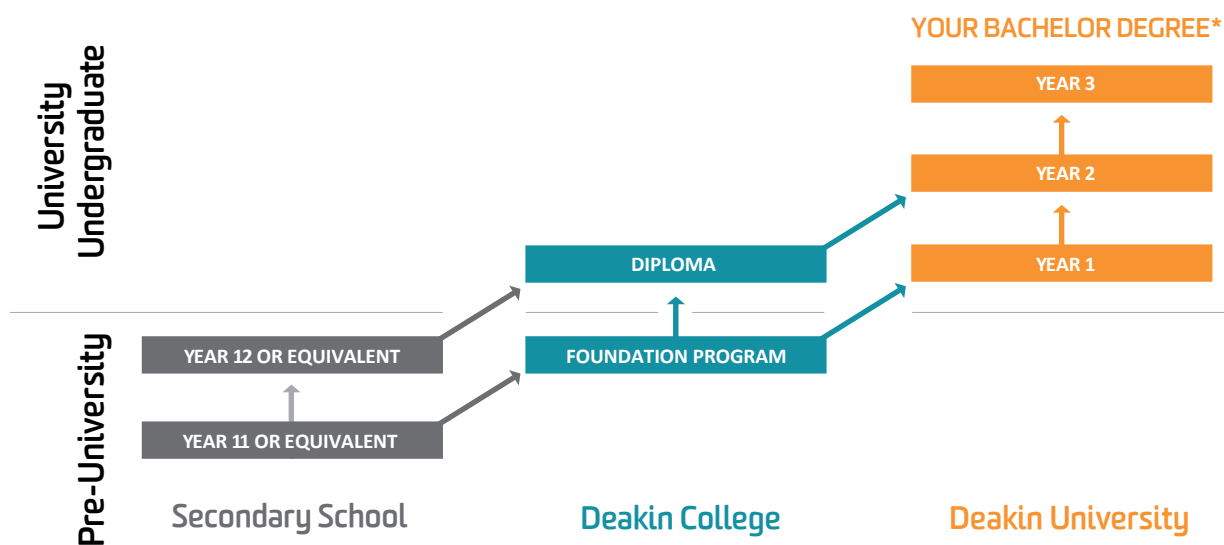


## Small class and tutorial groups
